### Journey through Service

#### Clinical

› Direct and indirect support to meet complex mental health needs in inpatient and community settings

› STOMP activity (Stop Overmedicating People with Learning Disabilities through outpatient and inpatient review)

• Approx. 180 staff across five service delivery areas including 5 bedded inpatient unit
